

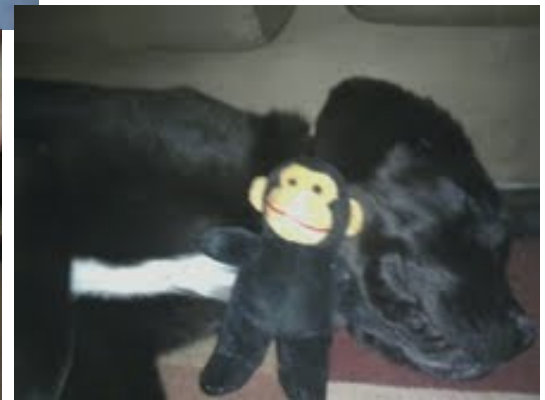


Chickie Dee and Princess Jasmine (left photo with little friend **Marek**) relax at their foster home.

All have been adopted.

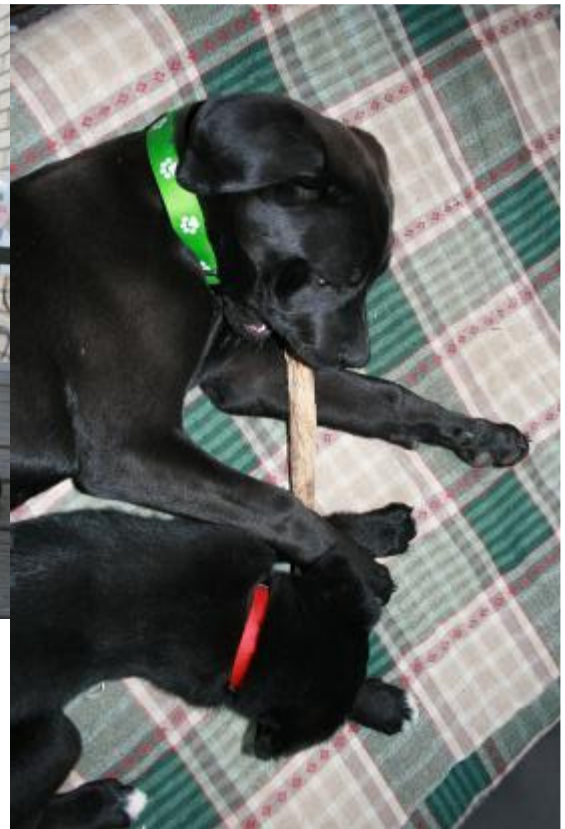
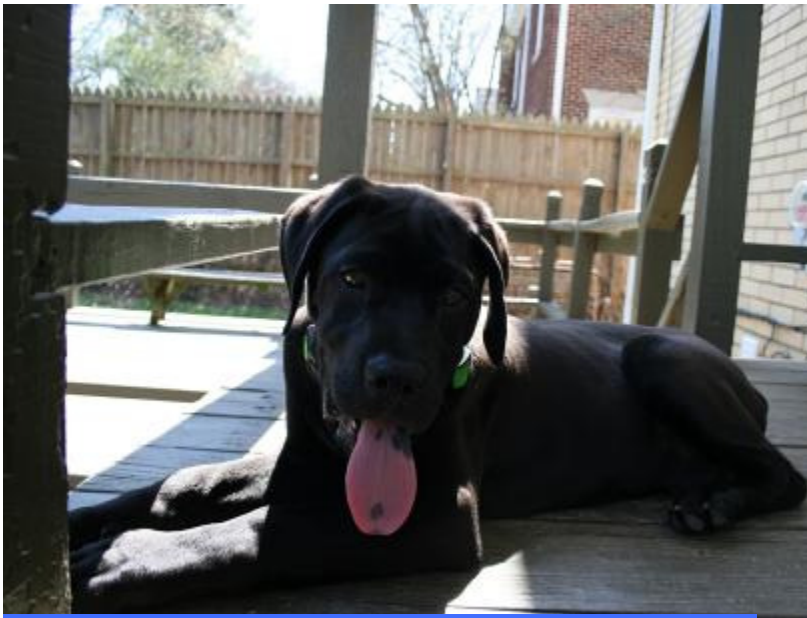


Chickie, now Kodiak, with his toy monkey.
